Thursday, November 1 – Please pray for FEBC US President Ed Cannon and board members who will be meeting today and tomorrow to discuss important ministry topics. Please pray for God’s guidance in their discussions and decision-making.

Friday, November 2 – Pray for Victor Akhterov, our director of **Russian** and **Ukrainian** ministries, as he oversees FEBC’s enormous and impactful work unfolding in both of these countries. Pray for God’s wisdom and discernment, as well as safety in travel. Pray, too, for staff and volunteers who are on the frontlines of ministry every day, producing broadcasts, responding to listeners, and connecting people to local churches.

Saturday, November 3 – FEBC has been sharing the Gospel in **Mongolia** for 18 years, reaching young adults eager to move beyond the Buddhist and atheist viewpoints held by their elders. And with modernization forcing many Mongolians to abandon their nomadic culture for city life, many transplants are now within reach of FEBC’s 10 radio stations. Please pray for our director, Batjargal, and his staff as they faithfully work to reach their country for Jesus.

Sunday, November 4 – A listener from **India** writes: *“I intended to commit suicide, but as I listened to your radio program, it comforted my heart. The broadcaster shared that if one is in Christ, he is a new creature. Thank you for your encouragement!”*

Monday, November 5 – A recent Listeners’ Conference was held in **Pakistan**, attended by 42 listeners who wanted to learn more about Jesus. Our Pakistan Director, Saleem, said that many important conversations took place, such as the authenticity of the Bible and why Moses was chosen to deliver the 10 Commandments. Attendees showed an eagerness to learn: *“Our teacher explained very clearly who Jesus is and why He is the only way.”* Please pray that these students will continue to seek the truth about Jesus Christ.

Tuesday, November 6 – Please pray for our new interim director of FEBC **Thailand**, Noppakhun, as he assumes many responsibilities, including the oversight of 17 ethnic language broadcasts in addition to our Thai programs.

Wednesday, November 7 – **Japan** is the least evangelized nation amongst industrialized countries, and yet we are still able to reach people who tune in to our daily programs, such as this listener: *“I’m fascinated by Christianity, yet I’m still deeply involved with Buddhist rituals with my family. It’s such a serious decision to follow Jesus... please advise me.”* Pray for our staff as they reach out to this listener and all listeners who hear the Good News but struggle with a faith that seems foreign to their traditions.

Thursday, November 8 – In 2017, FEBC distributed 14,578 radios to listeners, thanks to the support of donors who made them possible. Pray that many will tune into our broadcasts, hear the Gospel and respond to the gift of salvation, which God offers all who believe in His Son.

Friday, November 9 – A listener in **Vietnam** writes: *“In our village, we listen to your teaching on the radio, and many have accepted Jesus as their Savior. Please pray that we will continue to grow in the Lord.”* Please also pray for our Vietnamese staff who work under difficult circumstances. Vietnamese authorities are ever watchful, not pleased that the Christian faith removes fear from those who follow Christ.

Saturday, November 10 – Ethnic people groups are often the most responsive to the Gospel when they hear it in their native language. In **Vietnam**, we air programs in 19 ethnic languages; in **Thailand**, 17, and in **Indonesia** 6. These are just some of the many ethnic language programs FEBC broadcasts in daily. Pray for our team of broadcasters who faithfully prepare them.

Sunday, November 11 – *Pinoy Connection* is an important program presented by our **Philippines** team, to reach the many Filipinos working overseas. Pray for the effectiveness of these Internet broadcasts. We recently received this note from a Filipino family living in Vienna, Austria: *“Greetings in the Lord! We would like to thank you for your programs we can access through the Internet. We’re so blessed to be able to tune in and learn how to strengthen our spiritual walk with the Lord.”*

Monday, November 12 – This week a seminar will be held on the **Thailand** border for Khmu ministry leaders. Please pray for God’s wisdom for Sionh, our Khmu broadcaster, as he conducts training and in-depth Bible studies.

Tuesday, November 13 – FEBC is a founding member of **First Response Radio**, a disaster relief team trained to get to a disaster site and offer life-saving information via radio to survivors of natural catastrophes. Please pray for the teams. Pray for their safety and their discernment, as they share information that can unite separated loved ones, offer resources for shelter, food and medical attention, and calm troubled hearts.

Wednesday, November 14 – A percentage of our ethnic listeners cannot read or write, which makes radio the perfect medium for them to hear the Good News. The blind also tune into FEBC, where they can readily engage in Bible studies and other discussions on faith that might not be available to them otherwise.

Thursday, November 15 – Christianity once had a presence in **Yemen**, but it was wiped out by Muslim conquests in the 7th century. Now Yemen is one of the Arab world's poorest countries; please pray for the Yemeni people.

Friday, November 16 – Pray for ongoing encouragement and protection for all our team and the believers in **China** during this time of growing religious persecution.

Saturday, November 17 – Please pray for Jurie and his staff in **South Africa**, as they promote the radio ministry within their own country and help facilitate radio work in other African countries.

Your broadcasts provide spiritual direction and comfort for me when I am confused. I'm so glad that God established FEBC. I pray that many will be awakened through your ministry."*

Tuesday, November 20 – Please pray for the ministry team in **Indonesia**, a country with the largest number of Muslims in the world. Pray for Jusak, the director of our staff. Pray, too, for a good response from listeners who tune in to hear about God's hope and grace for mankind.

Wednesday, November 21 – *"Since I started listening to the Way of Life program, your radio station has given me hope and salvation,"* writes a listener from **Mozambique**. *"As a former Muslim, I would have died in my sins. Today, I'm happy to say that I have joined a church and I praise God for each new soul who joins God's Kingdom."* Praise God!

Thursday, November 22 – Thanksgiving is a day to give thanks to God for His abundant grace and blessings in our lives! Consider all the things you're thankful for. At FEBC, we're grateful for you, our faithful ministry partners, who help make this ministry of broadcasting the Gospel possible. Thank you!

Friday, November 23 – Praise God for technology and its ability to reach those in the furthest corners of the world. Pray that many will hear the Good News via radio, the Internet, satellite broadcasting, and mobile media.

Saturday, November 24 – A listener from **Ukraine** writes: *"Please pray that God will heal my soul. I will continue to listen to your programs because I believe that God's Word is powerful!"* Please pray that many souls will be healed as they grasp the depths of God's love for them.

Sunday, November 25 – FEBC is in the midst of raising funds for a brand new station that will reach all of **North Korea**. Please pray for all details to fall into place and for funds to become available to see this station come to fruition in 2019.

Monday, November 26 – Praise God that our Bai ethnic broadcasters resumed production this year. Pray for new programs that can be added to our broadcast schedule in November to reach the Bai people of **China**.
