Friday, March 1 – Praise God for a new life in Christ in **Myanmar!** The keeper of a local Buddhist shrine was attracted to a shortwave program that introduced him to the Gospel in his own language. Today he leads a church.

Saturday, March 2 – In **Thailand**, FEBC offers 17 ethnic language broadcasts. Programs are growing in popularity on digital apps as more people access the Internet, as well as our shortwave broadcasts. Pray for our team who oversee production of these ethnic programs.

Sunday, March 3 – New pressure on believers in **China** means that some people are staying away from Christian gatherings. Spiritual encouragement and fellowship are suffering as a result. Pray that believers will find ways to continue to meet.

Monday, March 4 – Thanks to the support of donors, FEBC provided incarcerated men in **Mongolian** jails with radios and Bibles. Many have since accepted Jesus as their savior. They now regularly listen to FEBC’s programs, where they learn more about Jesus and pray together. Please pray for these men who are trying to rehabilitate their lives with God’s guidance.

Tuesday, March 5 – Small, local house churches are springing up in response to FEBC broadcasts in **India**. Individuals face many challenges after they convert to Christianity from Hinduism. Please pray that God will unite these individuals so they can encourage one another in their newfound faith.

Wednesday, March 6 – Please pray for God’s daily direction for each of FEBC’s country directors, as they oversee staff and ministry demands. Please pray that God will grant them discernment and wisdom as they make decisions. Pray for protection as they travel. And pray for their families.

Thursday, March 7 – FEBC **Indonesia** owns seven stations and has begun broadcasting programs on 85 other stations to reach more provinces in this island

nation. Praise God for the expansion He has made possible. And pray for the staff overseeing this new development.

Friday, March 8 – Please pray for a Christian rehab center in Slavyansk, **Ukraine**. Hundreds of people have been delivered from drugs and alcohol addictions and joined the church. They have an opportunity to listen to FEBC broadcasts and participate in our programs. Pray that God will continue to bless this center and many more will find freedom in Christ.

Saturday, March 9 – Jesus communicated to people around Him through stories and parables, much the same way FEBC does in our broadcasts. Many of our listeners cannot read or write and rely on radio to hear the Gospel message. Pray for our broadcasters who invest a great deal of time producing programs intended to share the Good News to non-believers.

Sunday, March 10 – The Church in **Vietnam** is monitored closely and required to report its activities. But personal phone use is not monitored. That’s why FEBC is so involved in developing mobile technologies such as the Gospel Speaker Box. Also, FEBC’s use of audio visual content reaches the deaf community. Pray for our team and for future technologies to reach even more people.

Monday, March 11 – Today is the first day of FEBC’s annual international conference, where directors meet to share best practices, new technological advances to reach more people, prayer requests and much more. Please pray for God’s wisdom to be upon each of our directors who represent many of the countries where FEBC broadcasts are heard.

FEBC Day of Prayer: Please join us in a special day of prayer with FEBC staff around the world. Today we come together as one voice to ask God to bless the work of this ministry and to guide us throughout 2019. Every year we hope the harvest of souls will be greater and more lives will be transformed through the Good News of Jesus Christ. Wednesday, March 13 – Please pray for FEBC’s International Service Team (IST), a group of skilled technicians who oversee IT, disaster response, studio design, transmitter & antenna repairs, etc. One of the goals of IST is to build working relationships between FEBC’s numerous countries to maximize expertise and efficiency.

Thursday, March 14 – FEBC’s Liangyou Theological Seminary (LTS) offered through our **China** ministry was established in 1982 to meet the needs for in depth Bible training, especially in a country where so few seminaries exist. LTS’s intense 2 year program addresses core theology and moral character. Pray for LTS students to “love from a pure heart, have a good conscience and a sincere faith.” (1 Tim 1)

Friday, March 15 – Please pray for Ulanbek, FEBC’s program director in Central Asia and all of our broadcasters serving there. Pray that many non-believers will accept Jesus in **Kyrgyzstan** and **Kazakhstan**, countries that are culturally Muslim.

Saturday, March 16 – A listener from **Japan** wrote: *"I now listen to FEBC. Your programs cultivate my faith by giving me knowledge about Jesus and the Bible. A year ago I was a beginning student but now I call myself a Christian."* Please pray for this new life in Christ!

Sunday, March 17 – Praise God for the friendships and trust created by listening to radio regularly. Many listeners tell us they consider our broadcasters to be their friends.

Monday, March 18 – A listener from Southeast Asia writes: *"I thank God that I've been able to listen to FEBC all these years. Even when I didn't have a radio, I would listen with my phone and my whole family would listen, too, and find encouragement."* Pray for more hearts to be drawn to Jesus and more hearts to be changed... for all eternity!

Tuesday, March 19 – One of 86 ethnic groups that FEBC broadcasts to, the Hmong continue to grow and be encouraged by our programs. Once animistic, our programs have encouraged and brought many to Christ. *"We are still trying to understand how to live like Christians. Please pray for us,"* one listener told us. Please keep the Hmong and other ethnic minorities in your prayers.

Wednesday, March 20 – Pray for FEBC's powerful ministry in the **Philippines**, established in 1948 when China closed its doors to foreign missionaries. We are currently heard on 12 stations as well as worldwide on the Internet. Besides the main languages of English and Chinese, we also offer broadcasts in 27 ethnic languages in this island nation.

Thursday, March 21 – Please pray for our Khmu broadcaster in **Thailand**, who often conducts training and in depth Bible studies for ministry leaders. Please pray for these seminars, the attendees, and our broadcaster's safety and strength.

Friday, March 22 – Pray for Christians facing persecution in **North Korea** due to their Christian faith. Pray that God will give them the strength and unity they need to persevere.

Saturday, March 23 – Pray for wisdom for our team in **China**, as they often have to deal with challenges from authorities who feel threatened by the growing number of Chinese who are turning to God.

Saturday, March 30 – Pray for our team in **Cambodia** who are reaching people who have never heard the Good News of Jesus. Pray that our content will be relevant and full of truth.

Sunday, March 31 – Please pray for listeners like this one from **Korea**: *"I was so tired, so I turned on the radio. I could not pray because my heart was in despair: I could not stand before the Lord. However, I continue to listen to FEBC."* Pray that she will find the strength she needs through the redeeming power of the Holy Spirit.
