Saturday, June 1 – Pray that our 12 radio stations throughout the **Philippines** will encourage believers and lead others to faith in Christ. The Philippines is where FEBC launched its very first radio station in 1948. Since then, God has made it possible for us to be heard in 49 countries, an accomplishment also due to the generosity and faithful prayers of our partners.

Sunday, June 2 – Over a recent two-month period, FEBC International's Tibetan-language team, Gaweylon, wrote more than 700 letters to listeners to keep in touch, renew contacts, and introduce their programs to new listeners. Pray that the people who were contacted will continue to be blessed by our broadcasts.

Monday, June 3 – Pray for the ministry of FEBC International as they work to produce visual media content through Bible stories and Gospel material to reach the children of **Vietnam**. Through visual content, they are also reaching the deaf community. Praise God for His faithfulness!

Tuesday, June 4 – Please pray for FEBC **India** as they address issues of mistreatment against women. Through broadcasts, they discuss the importance of treating one another with love and respect as image bearers of God.

Wednesday, June 5 – Please pray for FEBC **Russia** staff as they follow up with listeners who contact our offices. Pray for guidance and wisdom as they minister to those in need.

Thursday, June 6 – Christians in **Japan** are less than 1% of the population. Please pray for continued strength and encouragement for FEBC's team, who produce the only Christian radio programs heard in all of Japan. Pray that listeners will respond to the Gospel.

Friday, June 7 – Please pray that First Generation Christians in **Kyrgyzstan** will continue to remain committed to their faith. Pray that they will find strength in a community of believers as they build one another up in Christ.

Saturday, June 8 – The UN Refugee Agency's annual report reveals close to 66 million people have been displaced around the world. Pray for FEBC, as they reach across borders and languages to share the Gospel with those who do not know Christ.

Sunday, June 9 – Today is Pentecost Sunday, which recognizes the day the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples and empowered them with the same power that Jesus possessed; this was the beginning of the Christian Church. Today is also the International Day for the Unreached (IDU), of which FEBC is a founding member. IDU is involved in mobilizing believers across North America and beyond to ignite a fresh passion to proclaim the Gospel to those who have never heard.

Monday, June 10 – Please pray for **China** as they encounter hardship due to religious restrictions. For FEBC, this is both a challenge and an opportunity. Diversifying communication channels, equipping leaders and reaching out to the younger generation are some of the changes made recently. Please pray for our FEBC China team during these challenging times.

Tuesday, June 11 – *"I am captivated by the stories I'm hearing about Jesus, which I've never heard in all my life; the message is totally new to me. After listening to your radio programs for a week, I decided to accept Jesus as my Savior."* Please pray for this precious life in Southeast Asia, and pray for the many hearts that are drawing closer to Christ each day.

Wednesday, June 12 – Please pray for Nepal, as Christian broadcasting is a challenge due to strict restrictions.

Thursday, June 13 – Please pray for inspiration and creativity for FEBC's broadcasters around the world. Pray, too, for strong national believers willing to share the word of God.

Friday, June 14 – Please pray for **Indonesia**, as they deal with the aftermath of a devastating flash flood that occurred in March; pray that God will restore hearts along with the land.

Saturday, June 15 – Please pray for FEBC **Ukraine** as they deal with individuals affected by conflict and war. A pastor in one of the towns shared: *"I am so glad FEBC is finally here. People who have experienced war, betrayal, and instability on so many levels are hungry for the truth. In a strange and painful way, the war became a blessing for us. So many people are looking for answers now."*

Sunday, June 16 – FEBC **Indonesia** airs a Child Protection Program to protect Indonesian children from abuse and drugs. They also provide counseling services. Please pray that the Child Protection Program will be heard by the youth of Indonesia, and as they listen, they will also come to understand God's love for them.

Monday, June 17 – Programs broadcast into **North Korea** mainly serve to teach and provide devotionals. This is crucial as most people in the country have not been exposed to the Christian faith. Pray that many more will hear the Gospel and choose to follow Jesus.

Tuesday, June 18 – Pray for FEBC staff and programmers in **South Korea** who ensure the successful broadcasting of the Gospel throughout **North Korea**. May the Lord bless, protect and inspire them.

Wednesday, June 19 – Pray for **Mozambique** as FEBC ministers to those affected by Cyclone Idai that killed hundreds and impacted thousands in this African nation. Pray for restoration in the land both physically and spiritually.

Thursday, June 20 – Please pray for this listener in Central Asia and praise God for his love: *“I accepted Jesus as my Savior. My parents don’t know God and they don’t like my tuning into your broadcasts, but I can’t stop because your messages give me hope and peace. I listen in the field and learn to sing the songs to praise God.”*

Friday, June 21 – Pray for broadcasts that reach Christians in **Yemen**, who must often meet in underground churches to worship. Pray that the words they hear will sustain their hearts and increase their faith in Christ.

Saturday, June 22 – FEBC is currently reaching 86 ethnic groups. Please pray for God’s guidance to reach each ethnic group in their own unique way. Thank God for His desire to reach all people...and for His instruction to us to *“make disciples of all nations.”*

Sunday, June 23 – Please pray for the FEBC team in Central Asia. Pray for the freedom to share the Gospel without government restrictions. Pray, too, for the staff to be equipped to speak on difficult topics such as alcoholism.

Monday, June 24 – FEBC Gospel Speaker Boxes are battery/solar powered and contain an SD card that allows programs to be heard where there is no radio coverage. Pray that the Speaker Boxes will reach those who are outside the range of our broadcasts and in areas hostile to the Gospel.

Tuesday, June 25 – Mrs. C* from **Vietnam** is a devoted Christian as a result of listening to FEBC’s broadcasts, but now that she is married she no longer has the freedom to practice her faith. Pray for the salvation of her husband.

Wednesday, June 26 – The military regime in **Myanmar** seeks to destroy Christianity, which it calls the “C virus.” Pray for believers to be strong in faith. *“Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven”* (Matthew 5:10).

Thursday, June 27 – Ido is from **Japan**. After listening to FEBC’s Internet broadcasts, he contacted our office. *“To tell the truth,”* he shared, *“I have been depressed these past few years. Through my experience, the human voice heard through radio is very special. FEBC’s programs are powerful. I will keep listening to them carefully. Thank you!!”* Please pray for Ido and all listeners tuned into FEBC Japan.

Friday, June 28 – Please pray for new, talented Christians to fill the roles of broadcasters, pastors, accountants, board members and directors at FEBC. Some senior staff are preparing to retire soon and we are looking for godly, talented people to raise up the next generation of FEBC’s team. Pray also for FEBC’s Leadership Academy, established to train emerging leaders.

Saturday, June 29 – *Reality Church* is a program recorded in a house church outside of **Yemen**, a precious encouragement for hidden Yemeni believers. Please pray for resources to continue this vital program.

Sunday, June 30 – A listener in **Vietnam** wrote: *“I am 18 years old. Because of my parents’ financial problems, I had to quit school. Every time I listen to your broadcasts, a wonderful joy fills my heart. My dream is that someday I will be able to go to different places to help many to be saved.”* Pray that God will help this young listener achieve her dream.
