

**Thursday, July 18** – Please keep the Liangyou Theological Seminary in your prayers. Pray for God’s protection upon our students and our Liangyou Radio listeners. May God provide teachers with wisdom and insight during this time of tighter religious restrictions in China.

**Friday, July 19** – FEBC Myanmar broadcasts in a variety of ethnic languages. Pray that the staff can build relationships with those who respond and for wisdom as they navigate differing cultures and languages.

**Saturday, July 20** – A listener in **Kazakhstan** said, “Your FEBC program has totally turned my life around.” Praise God for His redeeming love that saves lives and changes hearts. Pray for the people of Kazakhstan, that they would be open to the Gospel.

**Sunday, July 21** – FEBC **Kyrgyzstan** is looking for more talk-show hosts. Pray for strong believers eager to share the Good News of Jesus to join their team.

**Monday, July 22** – FEBC **Ukraine** began broadcasting from a new tower in Eastern Ukraine. This is helping to reach an additional 300,000 potential listeners, many of whom are living in the rebel-controlled territories where the church is under severe persecution. Please pray that many listeners will come to know the Lord.

**Tuesday, July 23** – Please pray for strength and perseverance for believers in **Pakistan**. Pray for protection of believers and comfort from the Holy Spirit as they share Christ with others.

**Wednesday, July 24** – Pray that FEBC **India’s** broadcasting programs will have a clear signal and for listeners to have the courage to contact them when they are in need. Some listeners fear relatives and neighbors in their communities who are opposed to Christianity.

**Thursday, July 25** – Twenty-one students recently graduated from FEBC **Cambodia’s** Bible class. This group studied for 3 months by means of Gospel Speaker Boxes. Praise the Lord for His faithfulness in enabling the team to equip students for the ministry.

**Friday, July 26** – Please pray for new, talented Christians to fill the roles of broadcasters, pastors, accountants, board members and directors at FEBC. Some senior staff are preparing to retire soon and we are looking for godly, talented people to raise up the next generation of FEBC’s team. Pray also for FEBC’s Leadership Academy, established to train emerging leaders.

**Monday, July 29** – Please pray for **India’s** *Koinonia* gatherings, where people come together to pray and enjoy fellowship with one another. Pray that many more members will find Christ through these meetings and that prayers will be answered.

**Tuesday, July 30** – FEBC **Thailand** received listener feedback from their *Hope and Encouragement* broadcast: “Listening to your program gives me encouragement, belief and more faith in God. Thank you, God, for your teaching... I am completing my final lesson in the Bible Correspondent Course. The lesson, the program and the team are very good to me. Thanks to everybody for everything. May God bless you.”

**Wednesday, July 31** – In the past, Muslim women in **Malawi** were not open to the Gospel, but this has now changed. Women often call the station to find out how they can become involved in the ministry. Through FEBC’s broadcasts, many have turned to Christ. Pray that many more women would come to know Jesus as their Savior.

And we see that when Zacchaeus welcomes Jesus into his home, the impact is remarkable. The impossible becomes possible. Zacchaeus repents and chooses to follow Jesus. Where Jesus is present, grace and new life abounds.

Pray with us that FEBC listeners who may be hearing about Jesus today for the first time will choose to accept Him as their Lord and Savior.

**Tuesday, July 2** – Please pray for the new radio stations in **Mongolia**. Praise God for His provision. The new stations in Choibalsan and Baruun-Urt will now reach 60,000 listeners previously unreached!

**Wednesday, July 3** – Please pray for **New Zealand**, as they heal from the devastating terrorist attack in March. Pray that many will turn their hearts to Jesus in this difficult time and that FEBC can reach those who are hurting.

**Thursday, July 4** – Today, as we celebrate Independence Day in the U.S., we are grateful for the freedoms of our country. Thankfully, we have the freedom to love and serve Jesus openly. However, many people in other countries live under harsh government persecution. Pray today for the strength of those living under these circumstances and for the peace of God in their lives.

**Friday, July 5** – Our program in **India** named *Protyasha*, which means hope beyond all imagination, strives to do just that. Pray that hearts will be touched by the Good News of Jesus. *“Protyasha changed my life,”* shared one listener. *“I fell in love with it and listen regularly.”*

**Saturday, July 6** – Saladin, once a Muslim Sheikh who gave his life to Jesus after having an encounter with Him in a dream, has since planted 20 listener clubs and continues to disciple its leaders. Pray that many will choose to follow Christ in **Malawi** as Saladin shares his powerful testimony.

**Sunday, July 7** – Half of the population of the **Philippines** is under the age of 24. Please pray for guidance on how to reach them. Pray, too, that God would lead staff in new, creative ways and technological advances that are relevant to the age group of listeners.

**Monday, July 8** – Pray for **India’s Good News for Every Tribe** initiative. This year they are focusing on reaching people groups in remote areas where access to the Internet and radio is difficult. By providing Speaker Boxes, people in remote areas are able to reliably hear the message of Jesus in their own language.

**Tuesday, July 9** – Please pray for the ethnic groups in the outer regions of **Thailand** who have been tuning in and responding to FEBC broadcasts. One listener who is illiterate thanks God that she can hear His Word daily through the radio. Please pray for more radios to be distributed so many more can hear the powerful message of God’s love.

**Wednesday, July 10** – Certain areas in **Mozambique** are facing violent rebel attacks. Radio Nuru’s recently established listener clubs are also situated in that area. Please pray for the protection of the listener clubs and that the violence would end.

**Thursday, July 11** – **China** is home to 56 ethnic groups. Currently, FEBC broadcasts in ten minority languages. Pray for China’s 56 ethnic groups and the growth of more broadcasts in minority languages in the future.

**Friday, July 12** – Last week a church elder connected with FEBC **Mongolia** staff and said, *“I now listen to Bible teaching regularly. The Book of James especially is an encouragement for me and it is supporting my spiritual growth.”* Six Bible studies from *Thru the Bible* were uploaded onto SD cards to help people in rural destinations listen to the content. The church elder has listened to them all and asked the staff for more. Praise the Lord for His faithfulness to open hearts for the Good News!

**Saturday, July 13** – Pray for FEBC **Cambodia** as they plan to launch a new station next year. Pray that God would provide the necessary staff and resources. If all goes well, this station could reach another 741,000 Cambodians with the Good News.

**Sunday, July 14** – Please pray that FEBC **Kazakhstan** would be able to attain an FM frequency in the Almaty region. Also, pray that the use of social media and other technology would be effectively implemented for sharing the Gospel.

**Monday, July 15** – *Voice of Love Cambodia* participated in a Disciple Making Movement Workshop. Forty people attended the meeting that encourages believers to share the Gospel with their community. Pray that the workshop will bear much fruit.

**Tuesday, July 16** – Please continue to pray for FEBC’s efforts to raise funds for the Evangelism Center in Kiev, **Ukraine**, as we need more space to produce programs, videos, and live broadcasts for our Ukrainian and Russian listeners.

**Wednesday, July 17** – Stations across the **Philippines** are in need of skilled staff members. Please pray for various staffing needs. May the Lord send people who are qualified and have a heart for FEBC’s mission.
